Importing references from PubMed Central (PMC) to RefWorks

In PMC,

- Select the references to be imported into Refworks.
- Click on Send To (upper right), then File, then in the FORMAT box select MEDLINE.
- Click on **Create File.** The file will be saved in the Downloads folder.

In RefWorks

- To import the references into RefWorks, select "References", "Import" from the top menu bar.
- Select NLM PubMed as the Import Filter and PubMed as the database and select the text file you created
- Click **Import** and the references will be imported into RefWorks.
