

Configuration Directions for Internet Explorer

For remote access to the UNIC Library e-resources

- Select “**Tools**” from the Internet Explorer menu bar
- Select “**Internet Options**” from the pull-down menu
- Click on the “**Connections**” tab
 - If you use a cable modem or DSL connection: click on the **LAN Settings** box
 - If you use a dial-up connection: in the **Dial-up and Virtual Private Network settings** box, click on “**Settings**”
- In the Settings window, make sure both “**Automatically detect settings**” and “**Use automatic configuration script**” are unchecked
- In the **Proxy server** box, check the “**Use a proxy server**” tickbox
- In the box following “**Address**” type: **proxy.unic.ac.cy**
- In box following “**Port**” type: **8080**
- Check the “**Bypass for proxy server**” tickbox

Note: click on **OK** buttons in both windows, don't just close them

- The proxy server responds with a login window. If not, refresh/ reload your page
- Log in with your **proxy Username** and **Password**. When approved, you will be able to access all of the Library e-resources available at www.library.unic.ac.cy

When you have finished searching Library electronic resources, be sure to go back to the Proxies window and uncheck the “**Use a proxy server**” tickbox.
