

## Configuration Directions for Mac Browsers

*For remote access to the UNIC Library e-resources*

- Open **Safari** (or other browser)
- Choose “**Apple menu > System Preferences**”, and then click “**Network**”
- Choose the network service you use from the list, Wifi, Ethernet or AirPort for example
- Click “**Advanced**”, and then choose the “**Proxies**” tab
- Select “**Web Proxy (HTTP)**”.

- In the fields on the right, type  :
- Select the “**Proxy server requires password**” checkbox.
- Enter your proxy **Username** and **Password**

- Do the same for “**Secure Web Proxy (HTTPS)**”

(All the other boxes on the list should be unchecked)

- Select “**Secure Web Proxy (HTTPS)**”.
- In the fields on the right, type  :
- Select the “**Proxy server requires password**” checkbox.
- Enter your proxy **Username** and **Password**

- Click on “**OK**”, and then “**Apply**” button
- Close “**Network**” tab
- Go to the Library’s webpage [www.library.unic.ac.cy](http://www.library.unic.ac.cy) and you will be able to access all of the available e-resources

When you have finished searching Library electronic resources, be sure to go back to the Proxies window and uncheck the “**Web Proxy (HTTP)**” and “**Secure Web Proxy (HTTPS)**” tickboxes. You can easily tick them again; in case you need access.
